





Next-generation solutions for cultural heritage buildings

INHERIT is an EU-funded project aimed at promoting energy and resource efficiency, sustainability, resilience, and inclusiveness of cultural heritage buildings.

The overall vision is to co-design, develop, demonstrate, validate and replicate next generation solutions for sustainable, inclusive, resource-efficient and resilient Cultural Heritage

- accompanied by leading-edge Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs), such as Internet of Things (IoT), Artificial Intelligence (AI) and (big) data analytics
- enabling socially innovative and cost-effective interventions at different urban levels (buildings and city/neighbourhood),
- covering all relevant aspects of the heritage-built environment's life cycle: (1) Design and renovation; (2) Monitoring, operation and management; (3) Preservation and maintenance.



INHERIT will test solutions in 8 real-life cultural heritage sites across 8 countries:







We intend to select at least **20 additional historic urban areas** to follow the project, share there knowledge and potentially develop their own hubs of innovation.
